GENERAL PURPOSE:

Play a crucial role in providing safe and effective anesthesia care to patients undergoing various surgical procedures in our ambulatory surgery center. This position offers the opportunity to work in a physician owned medical practice dedicated to delivering high-quality patient care.

MAIN DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Perform pre-anesthetic assessments and evaluations of patients to determine their anesthesia needs and develop individualized anesthesia care plans.
- 2. Administer anesthesia according to established protocols and standards of care.
- 3. Monitor patients' vital signs and physiological responses throughout the perioperative period, adjusting anesthesia as necessary to ensure patient safety and comfort.
- 4. Manage anesthesia-related emergencies and complications promptly and effectively, collaborating with other healthcare providers as needed.
- 5. Provide post-anesthesia care as appropriate.
- 6. Document anesthesia care, patient assessment findings, and perioperative events accurately and comprehensively in the medical record.
- 7. Collaborate with providers, nurses, and other members of the healthcare team to optimize patient outcomes and ensure smooth perioperative care processes.
- 8. Participate in quality improvement initiatives and adhere to regulatory requirements and accreditation standards related to anesthesia services.
- 9. Maintain proficiency in anesthesia techniques, equipment, and pharmacology through ongoing education and professional development activities.
