Job Summary

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Focus on managing symptoms, optimizing nutritional intake, and supporting overall digestive health.
- Educate and counsel patients on their relationship with nutrition and gastrointestinal health.
- Provide guidance on dietary modifications, food choices, and lifestyle adjustments.
- Collaborate with physicians and other healthcare professionals to ensure coordinated and comprehensive patient care.
- Administer PEG tube feedings as needed.
- Participate in multidisciplinary team meetings to discuss patient cases and contribute valuable nutritional insight.
- Monitor patient progress and adjust nutrition plans as needed.
- Conduct follow-up appointments to assess improvement, address concerns and provide ongoing support.
- Stay abreast and use the latest research, advancements and best practices in gastroenterology and nutrition.
